This women's and gender history of the Austrian revolution and council movement examines the period of transformation from the Habsburg Monarchy to the First Austrian Republic from a new perspective. On the one hand, the study examines how gender affected the participation of women in the revolution. On the other hand, it makes women visible as actors who used the transformation process after the founding of the Austrian Republic to fight for a better world. The hypothesis of the study is that our understanding of the revolutionary processes and the council movement in Austria changes significantly if women are considered as actors. Such perspective ultimately contributes to rethinking our ideas of revolution in general.
